



Lucy Sun Hwang, PhD

Dr Lucy Sun Hwang is presently the Professor Emeritus of National Taiwan University at the Graduate Institute of Food Science and Technology. She received her BS degree in Chemistry from National Taiwan University in 1970 and PhD degree in Food Science from Rutgers University in 1975. She started her teaching and research career at National Taiwan University in 1978, and was Director of the Institute of Food Science and technology from 1988 – 1991.

Dr Hwang is Founding President of International Life Sciences Institute Taiwan Branch, Delegate of Adhering Body and Fellow of Academy, International Union of Food Science and Technology, and Institute of Food Technologists Fellow. She is also the Chief Editor of

Journal of Food and Drug Analysis. She serves as advisor to many government agencies in Taiwan, including Taiwan Food and Drug administration; Ministry of Health and Welfare; Ministry of Economic Affairs; Council of Agriculture; and Ministry of Science and Technology.

Dr Hwang is also on the Board Directors of many research institutes in Taiwan, including Food Industry Research and Development Institute; China Grain Products Research and Development Institute; and CAS Taiwan Premium Agricultural Products Development Institute, which is a Certified Agricultural Standards certifying organization. In addition, she is heavily involved with the promotion of health through her role as Board Director of many non-profit organizations, such as John Tung Foundation; Professor Jean May Tsiang Foundation; Chweng Ching Child Nutrition Research Foundation; and Nutrition Foundation of Taiwan. She was also the President of Taiwan Millennium Health Foundation.

Dr Hwang's major research interest is "Health Effects of Food Components" including the preparation, analysis, biological evaluation, and bioavailability study of functional ingredients.
